Checking for free school meal (FSM) eligibility

The criteria for eligibility for FSM are set nationally. Together For Children verify eligibility with information held by the Dept. of Work and Pensions/Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs as the FSM team does not have access to information about the benefits that applicants receive.
